


SEEKING SCRIPTURE

- 1 Hebrew word for the Biblical feasts, also called appointed times or holy days
- 4 Author of Deuteronomy who spent his final months urging Israel to obey YHWH
- 6 What Israel lacked when they believed in YHWH but could not trust Him to care for them
- 9 A false prophet can be identified because their teaching does this to the word of YHWH (Deut 13 test #1)
- 11 River Israel was to cross over to dispossess nations mightier than themselves (Deut 9:1)
- 13 Deuteronomy 19 requires two or three of these to establish any case against a person
- 15 Great and tall people Israel was to face when crossing the Jordan (Deut 9:2)
- 17 Eleventh month on the Hebrew calendar, when Moses began his final address
- 18 Famous passage from Deuteronomy 6:4 beginning "Hear, O Israel"; means to hear AND do
- 19 YHWH's love language, according to Deuteronomy 11:1
- 21 First Biblical feast reviewed in Deuteronomy 16; never abolished in YHWH's word

- 2 Hebrew title of Deuteronomy, meaning "words"
- 3 Greek word for the five books of Moses
- 5 Number of years Israel wandered in the desert because of disobedience and lack of faith
- 7 Author credited with Deuteronomy chapter 34, which records Moses's death
- 8 Mountain where YHWH spoke directly to the people face to face (Deut 4:10)
- 10 Hebrew name for the first five books of the Bible, completed by Deuteronomy
- 12 Hebrew word meaning "to grow strong," root of the ancient battle cry "Rak Chazak Amats"
- 14 Deuteronomy 14 describes this as produce and livestock, not money
- 16 Provision in the wilderness that taught Israel man does not live by bread alone (Deut 8:3)
- 20 Hebrew word meaning valor or strength, used for both warriors and the "virtuous woman" of Proverbs
- 22 Deuteronomy 19 establishes cities of _____ for those who kill unintentionally
